For the third straight year, students of the All Schools Elementary Honor Orchestra at UCLA can proudly call themselves Emmy® winners.

The annual televised concert from Schoenberg Hall - *Orchestra Kids* - has been awarded a Los Angeles area Emmy award for the past three years.

Originally shot for local public access station LA36, the program has been aired nationally on UCTV as well as locally on PBS station KLCS. *Orchestra Kids* airs for the first time in high definition this month on KCET channel 28 - the nation's largest independent public television station.

*Orchestra Kids* goes behind the scenes with the All Schools Elementary Honor Orchestra at UCLA as it prepares for its annual concert in renowned Schoenberg Concert Hall.

Combining touching interviews with student musicians and a dramatic formal concert, featured performers share inspiring details of their lives and love of music.

Produced and directed by Larry Newman, *Orchestra Kids* is a life-affirming documentary which celebrates music education. The orchestra kids make music that inspires not only their parents, but also anyone who is interested in music, the arts and education in our schools.

# Meet the Music Director



**Larry Newman** is the Founder and Director of Children's Music Workshop. He holds a Bachelor of Music Education, *cum laude* degree from Temple University's College of Music, a California teaching credential and a Master of Arts in Music Performance from Eastern Illinois University.

Formerly an instrumental music teacher in the Philadelphia School District, LAUSD, and Santa Monica-Malibu Public Schools, Mr. Newman has supervised music programs in more than eighty public and private institutions from the Kindergarten through college levels.

In July 2010, Larry Newman was the recipient of the Academy of Television Arts and Sciences' 62nd Annual Los Angeles area Emmy® award for Children/Youth Programming. This was Mr. Newman's third Emmy win. He also received an Emmy in 2008 and 2009 for those years' All Schools Elementary Honor Orchestra telecasts from UCLA's Schoenberg Hall.

In 2009, Mr. Newman was honored by the Los Angeles City Council at Cit Hall for his contributions to music education in Los Angeles and in 2006 Mr. Newman received The Lori Petrick Excellence in Education Award from the Palisades Charter Schools Foundation. The award is underwritten by the Boone Foundation - a philanthropic group whose mission is to support "passionate people who provide excellent programs to youth".

Larry Newman was also one of 40 teachers nominated for the 25th Annual BRAVO Award, established in 1982 by the Music Center of Los Angeles County to recognize individuals for innovation and excellence in arts education.

As a professional trumpet player, Larry Newman has toured the U.S., Canada and Japan with The Glenn Miller Orchestra® performed in The Claridge Hotel Casino Orchestra in Atlantic City and sailed the Caribbean and Northwest with numerous cruise ships. He has performed with such artists as Dizzy Gillespie, Jack Jones, Florence Henderson, Jerry Lewis, The Fifth Dimension, Shirley Jones, The Lettermen, Jim Nabors, Jerry Van Dyke, Michel Legrand, Clark Terry, Cab Calloway, Benny Carter, Joe Williams, The Smothers Brothers, Rita Moreno and others.

Mr. Newman is the author of woodwind, brass and string method books used in all Children's Music Workshop school music programs. Additionally, his recorder book, *The Recorder Fun Book*, is used in hundreds of schools throughout the country and is now one of the top selling recorder methods in the nation.
